1. ORGANIZATION The Event is organized by abe - advanced business events, a limited company with a stated capital of 50.000 Euros, whose registered head office is located at 10, rue de la Rochefoucauld SC 50300 - 92513 Boulogne-Billancourt - France, hereafter referred to as the Organizer.

2. PURPOSE These regulations stipulate the terms and conditions according to which the Organizer sets up and runs the Event. They detail the respective rights and obligations of the Organizer and the signing company, hereafter referred to as the Participant. The Participant formally undertakes to abide by these regulations.

3. PLACE AND DATE The Event will be held at the Place and Date indicated here above. The Organizer may cancel the Event or change the Place and Date, should the Place be rendered unavailable, in case of force majeure or act of God. In such an event, no compensation or refund shall be due to the Participant. 4/ REGISTRATION, CANCELLATION, PAYMENT

6. OBLIGATION TO PRODUCE A RESULT The Organizer undertakes to diligently use the resources available to it without being subject to an obligation to produce any results.

7. INSURANCE The Organizer is the sole legal responsible for the Event. However the Organizer's responsibility shall not be engaged for any damage caused to the Participant by a third party. The Place is the sole legal responsible for the facility and premises, permanent or temporary, used for the Event, as well as all companies and activities operating and running under their direct request. The Participant must hold an insurance policy that covers all damages caused by them, their staff or their belongings to a third party. 8. APPLICABLE AMENDMENTS
